1997 WISCONSIN ACT 222

AN ACT *to amend* 39.30 (3m) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** increasing the maximum amount of tuition grants awarded by the higher educational aids board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 39.30 (3m) (a) of the statutes, as created by 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, is amended to read:

39.30 (3m) (a) No grant awarded under this section may exceed ~~\$1,086~~ \$1,150 per semester or a prorated

amount in the case of a quarter or trimester institution, or ~~\$2,172~~ \$2,300 per academic year. Grants under this section may not be less than \$250 during any one academic year.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to tuition grants awarded for the 1998–99 academic year.
