

Emergency Guidelines

- Visitors in the Capitol Building will receive emergency notifications by building alarms, public address announcements, and via Capitol staff. Follow the direction of Tour Guides, First Responders and Building Mgmt.
- <u>Employees</u> are responsible for knowing where exits, fire alarms and emergency equipment are located. how to activate fire alarm pull stations, and execute evacuation or sheltering procedures.
- <u>Supervisors</u> are responsible for the safety of employees, contract staff and visitors. Supervisors are responsible
- for ensuring employees are familiar with emergency procedures and employee accountability after evacuation.
