

2007–08 Wisconsin Statutes

Errata:

The coverage of the 2007-08 statutes contained on the title page and softbound cover contains an error. It should read:

This edition contains the general statutes of Wisconsin, including the acts of the 2007-08 Legislature at its regular session ending May 28, 2008, and special sessions beginning January 2007, October 2007, December 2007, March 2008 and April 2008. This edition contains annotations continuing those published in the Wisconsin Annotations 1970. The statutes in this edition may be cited as Wisconsin Statutes 2007-08 or as 2007 stats.

Section 16.9645 (1) (d), Wis. Stats. 2007-08, is incorrect as printed. It should read as follows:

Section 16.9645 (1) (d) “Public safety agency” has the meaning given in s. 146.70 (1) (g).

Figure 20.005 (3), Wis. Stats. 2007–08, is incorrect as printed. The entry for 20.434, Board for people with developmental disabilities, on page 567 of Volume 1 is incorrect. There is no s. 20.434. The appropriation for the Board for people with developmental disabilities is at s. 20.438, which is correctly reflected in Figure 20.005 (3) on page 575 of Volume 1.

Section 101.65 (1m), Wis. Stats. 2007-08, is incorrect as printed. It should read as follows:

101.65 (1m) May not issue a building permit to a person who is required to be certified under s. 101.654 unless that person, on applying for a building permit, produces a certificate issued by the department or other evidence satisfactory to the department showing that the person is in compliance with s. 101.654.

Section 101.654 (1) (a), Wis. Stats. 2007-08, is incorrect as printed. It should read as follows:

101.654 (1) (a) Subject to par. (b), no person may obtain a building permit unless the person annually obtains from the department a certificate of financial responsibility showing that the person is in compliance with sub. (2), completes the continuing education requirements described under sub. (1m), and furnishes to the issuer of the permit proof of completion of those continuing education requirements.
